Policy document for award of Freeship /Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

Jai Hind college supports the students by giving them various scholarships and freeships. These scholarships are awarded by variety of Government, Non government bodies, Industry, Philanthropists etc...The purpose of the scholarship/freeship is to cover the expenditure towards the tuition fees, books, periodicals etc.

PROCEDURE TO SELECT CANDIDATES

- 1. The students are informed about the freeships and scholarships for which they can apply during orientation and subsequently via notices.
- 2. The notices are also displayed prominently on students notice boards.
- 3. The eligibility criteria are clearly mentioned in it. Students with a minimum of 65% marks can only apply.
- 4. The students fill in the form and submit the required documents like their marksheet, parents IT return etc.
- 5. The forms are scrutinized by the committee.
- 6. The list of scholars from each department is prepared by inputs from the individual departments.
- 7. For some scholarships like Sumitomo, interview of the candidates who have applied is taken.
- 8. The final list of the deserving candidates in different categories is prepared in consultation with the Principal.
- 9. The selected candidates list is also displayed on the notice board.
